The publication includes the data from state statistical observations, administrative data from the Ministry of Social Policy of Ukraine, the Ministry of Health of Ukraine, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, the State Treasury Service of Ukraine and the Pension Fund of Ukraine.

To the attention of the users: the information presented in the publication is based on the results of the state statistical observations for 2014–2020 and does not include the data from the temporarily occupied territory of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, the city of Sevastopol and a part of temporarily occupied territories in the Donetsk and Luhansk regions (except table 1.2).

In some cases, the summation of presented figures may not be equal to their mathematical sum due to rounding.

A key indicator of the national accounts system (SNA) is a gross domestic product (GDP), an integrated indicator of a country's economic development, which characterizes the output of industrial activity of residents within the country's economic territory and is measured by the aggregate value of goods and services produced for the end use.

According to the preliminary estimates, the nominal GDP in 2020 amounted to UAH 4191,9 billion. Its volume per person stood at UAH 100415. At the same time, the actual final consumption of households in the GDP structure by expenditures accounted for 84,4%, and per person - UAH 84689.




