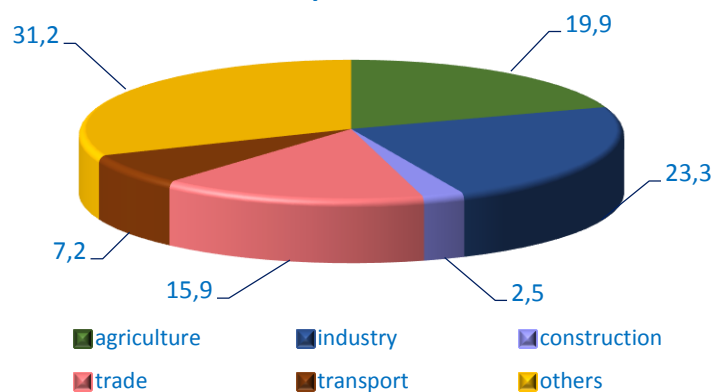

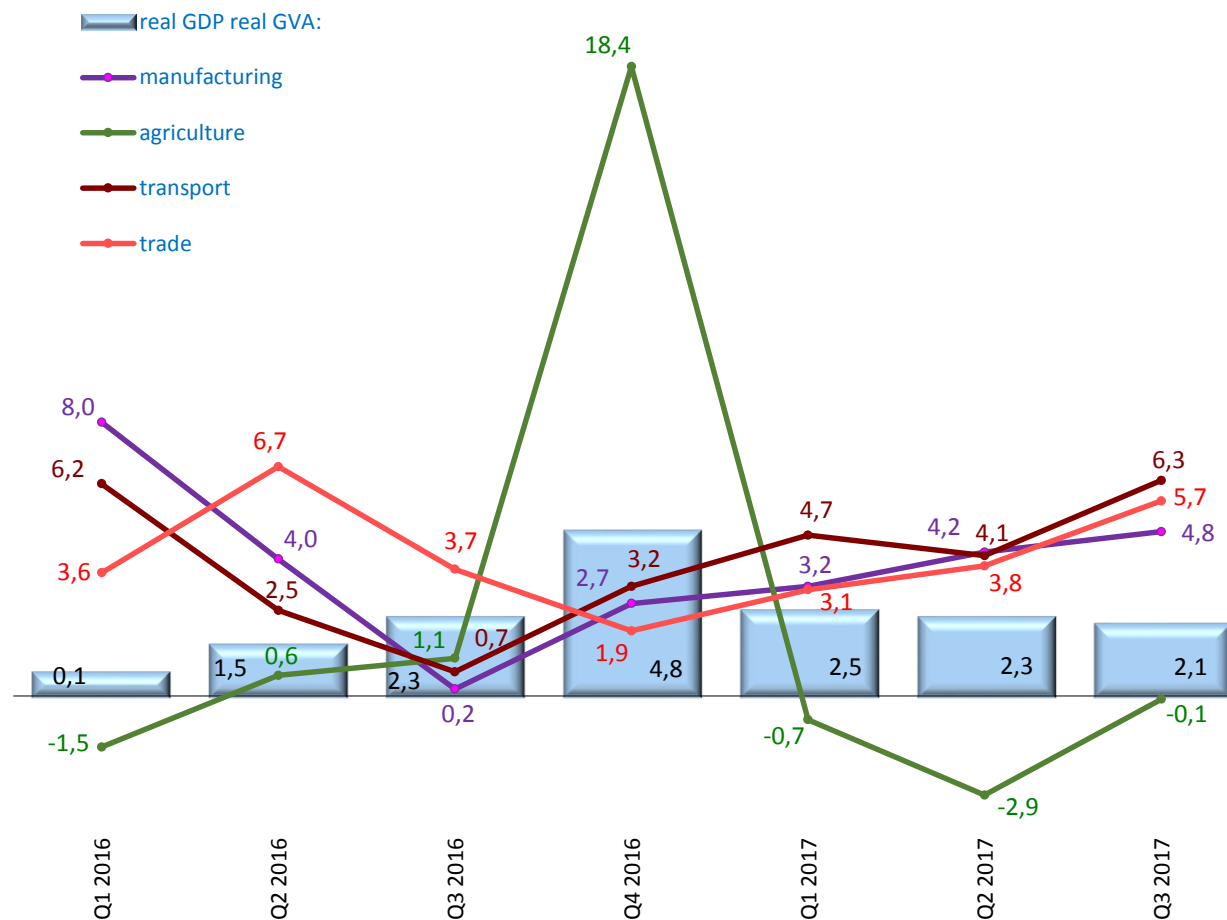
Gross value added structure

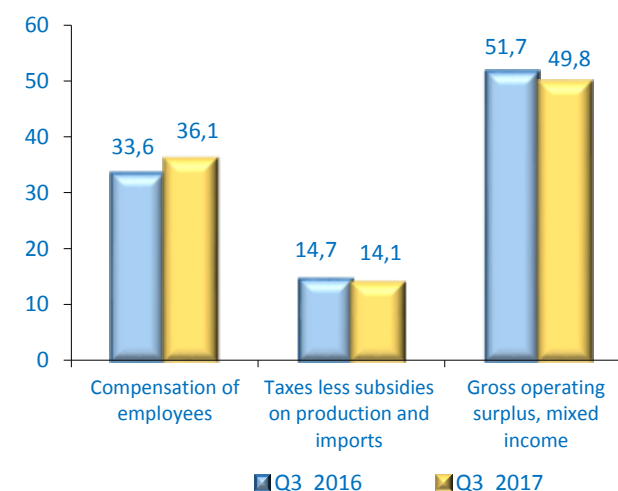

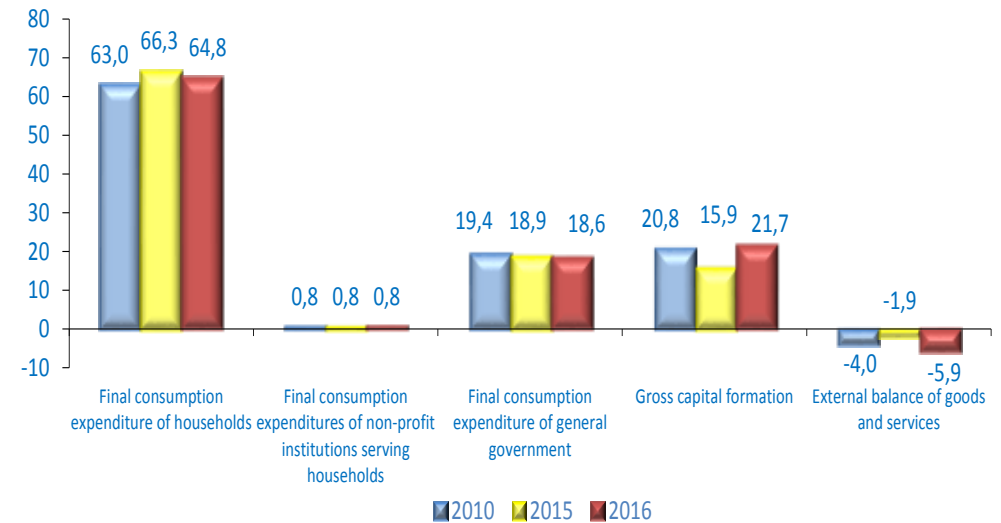

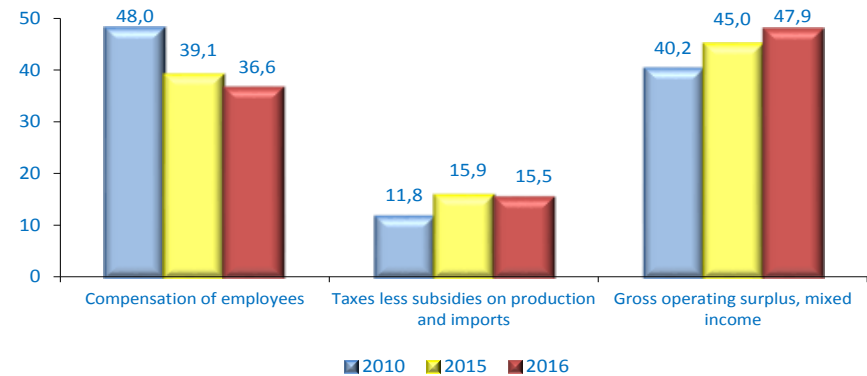

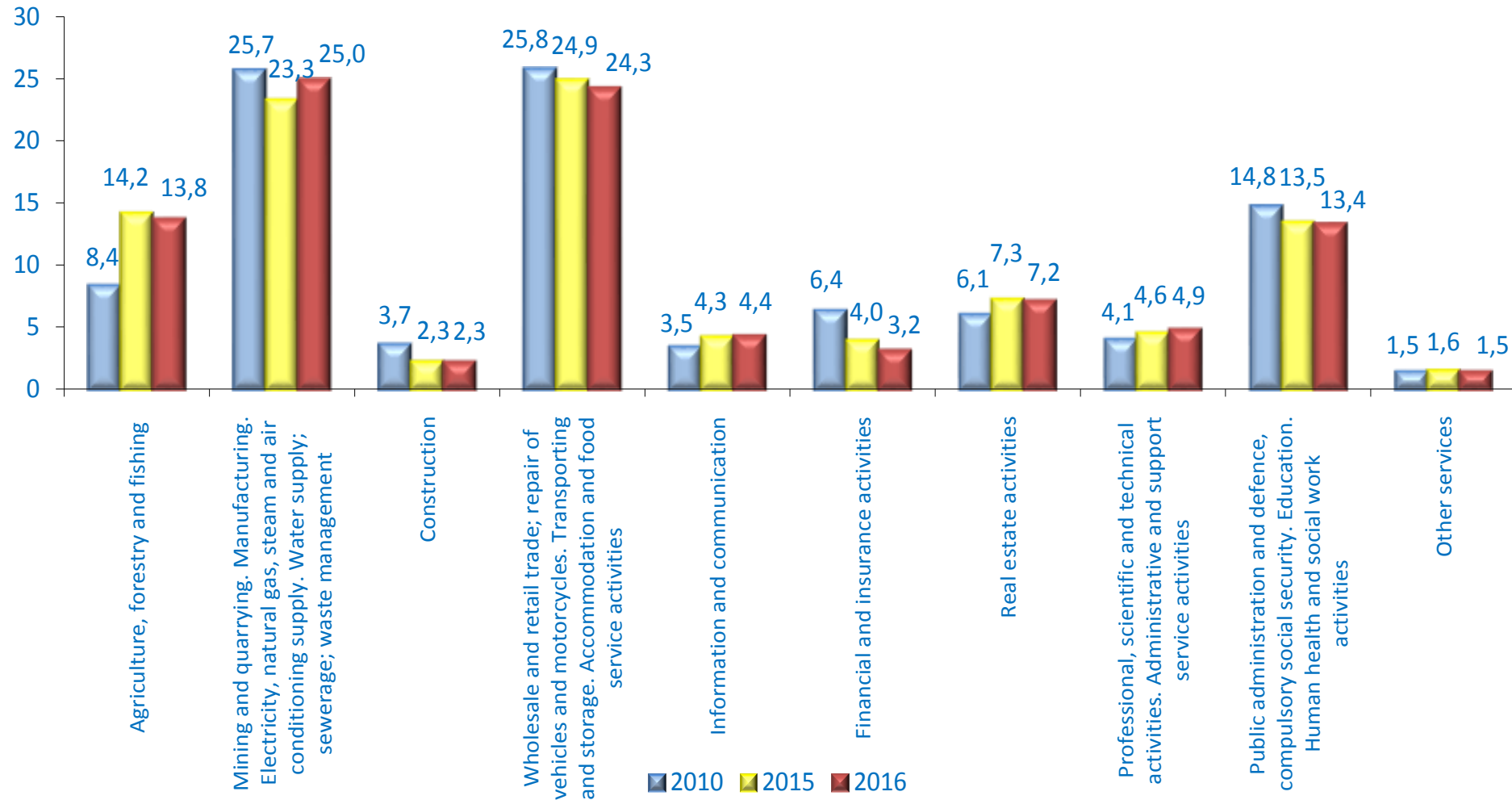

Gross value added structure by type of economic activity, %





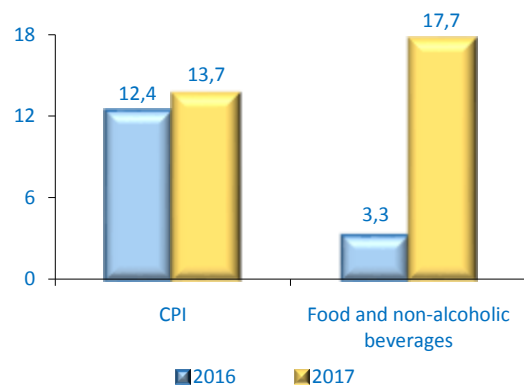

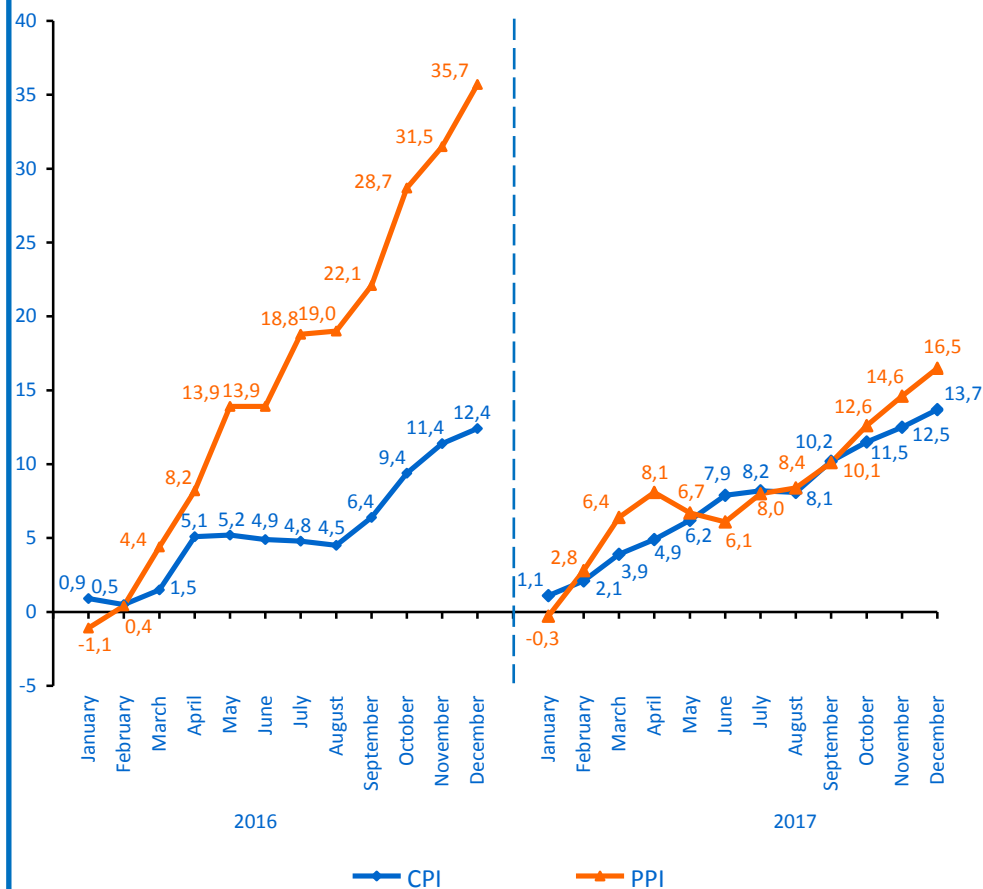

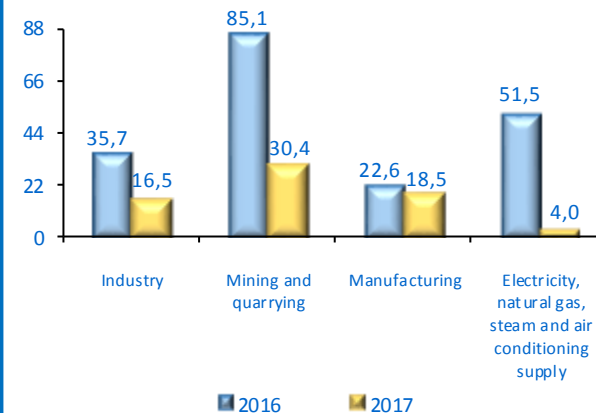
CPI and PPI changes, %

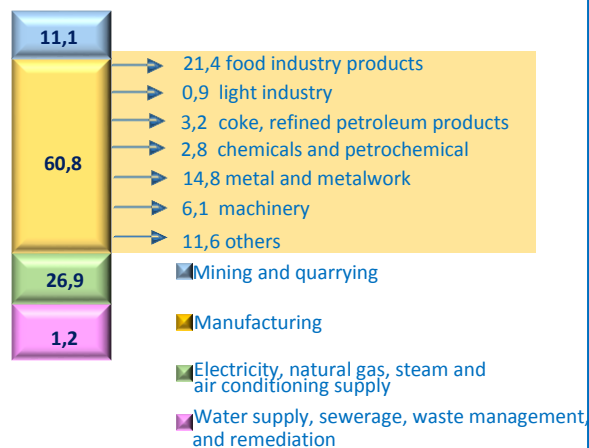




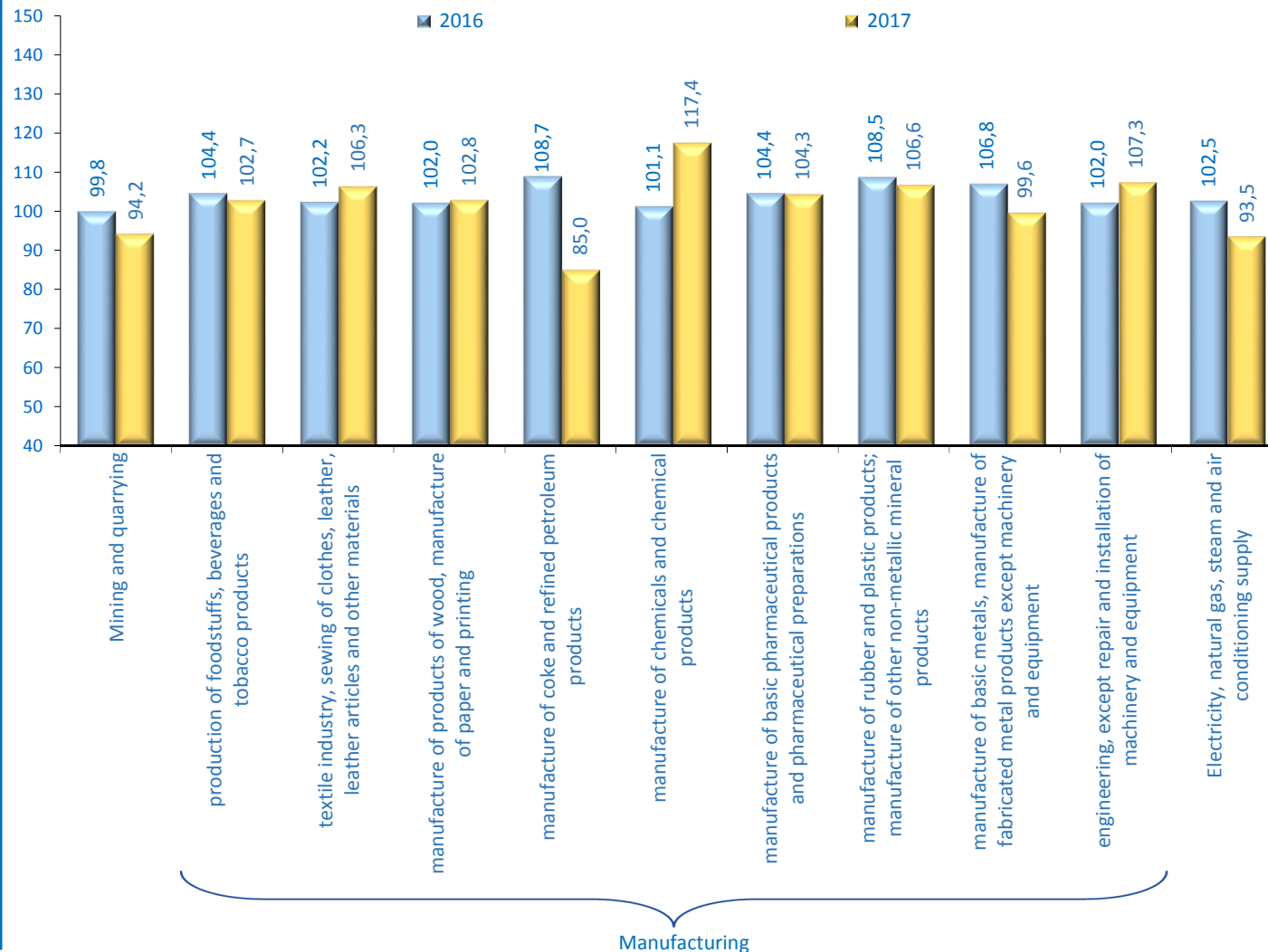

Index of industrial production by type of activity, % (to the corresponding period of the previous year)

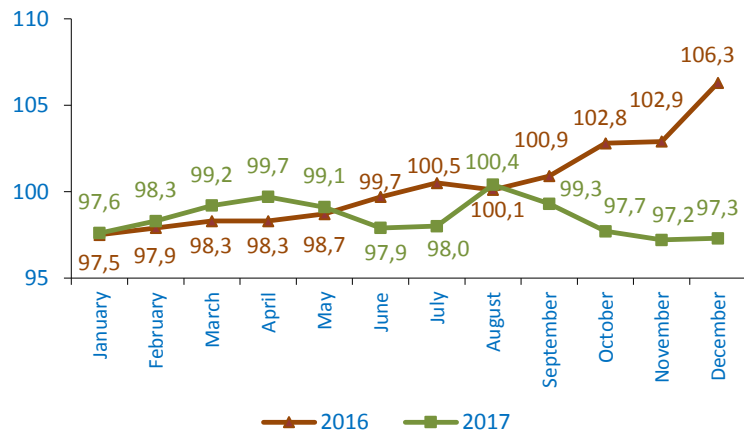

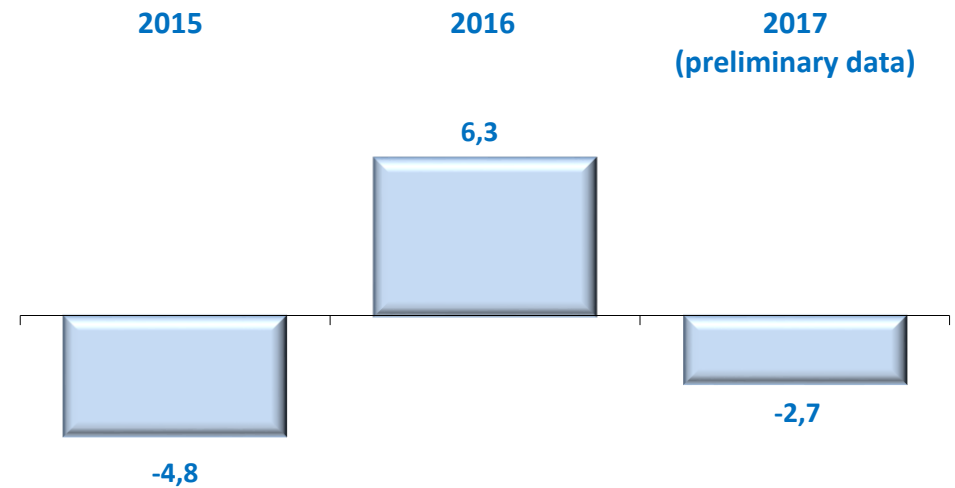

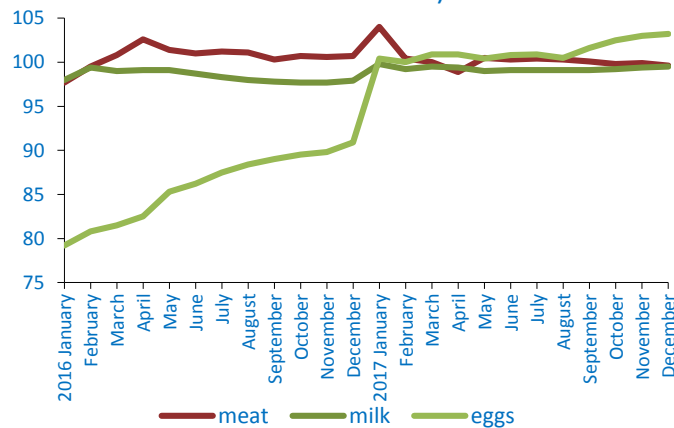

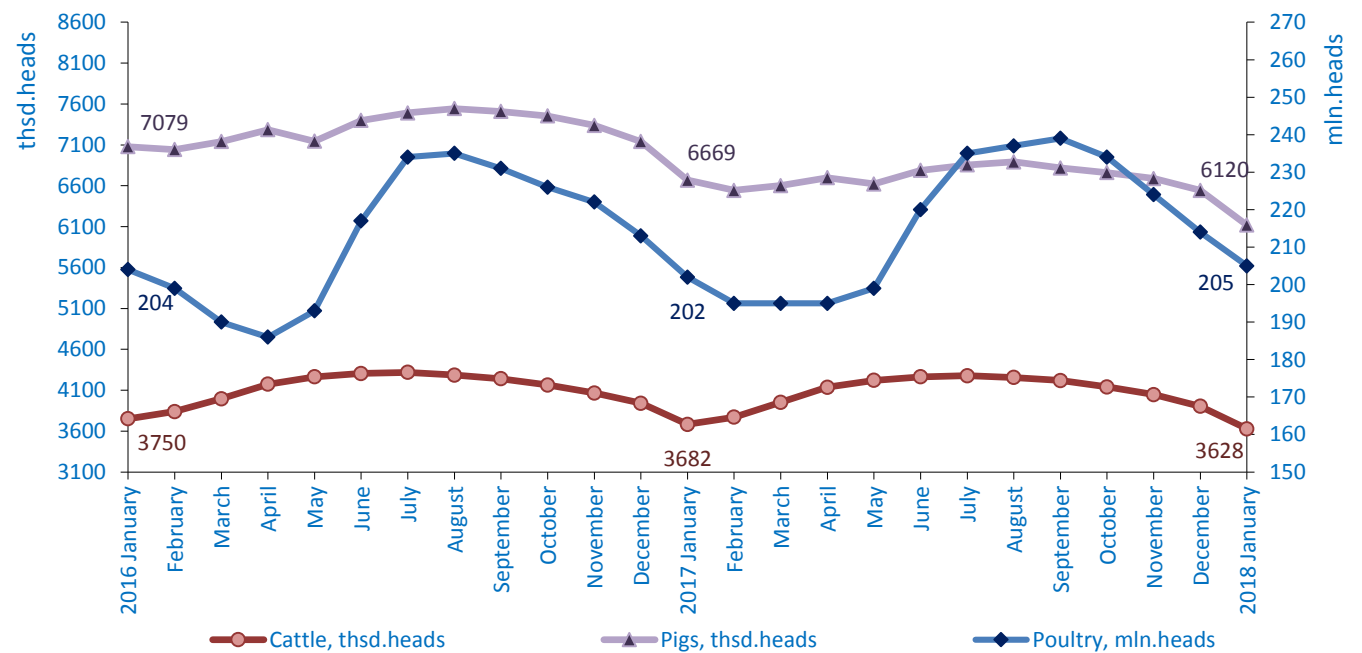

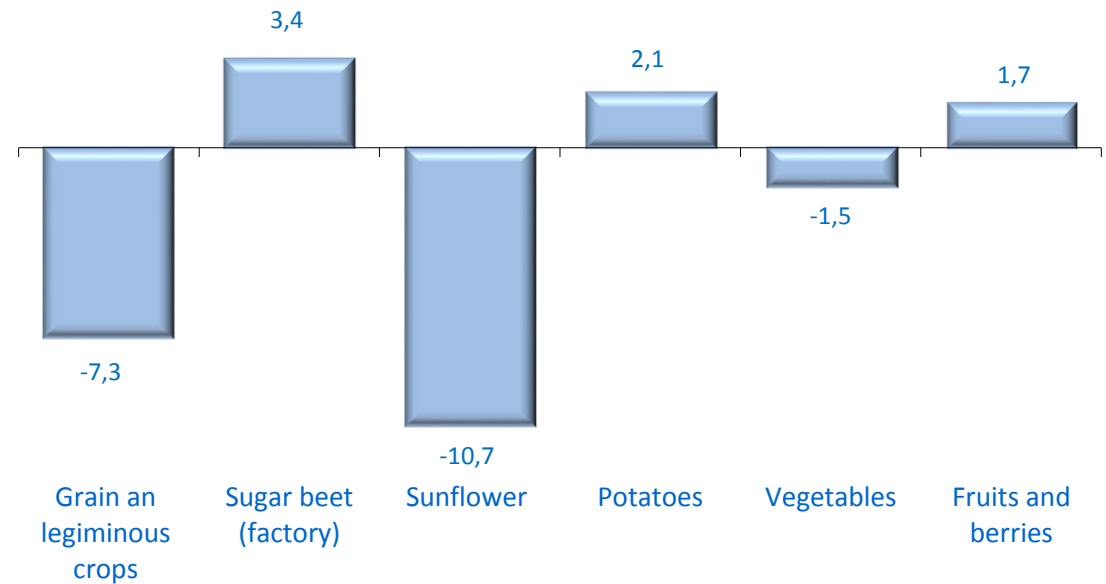

Increase, decrease (–) of yields to the previous year, %

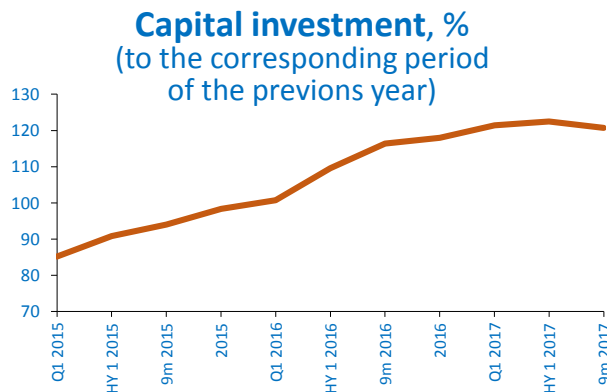

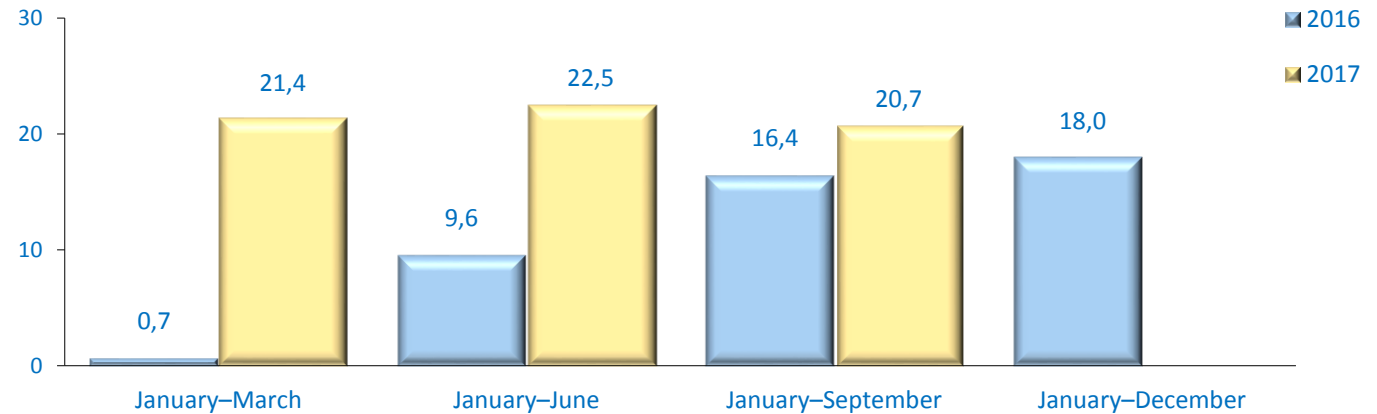

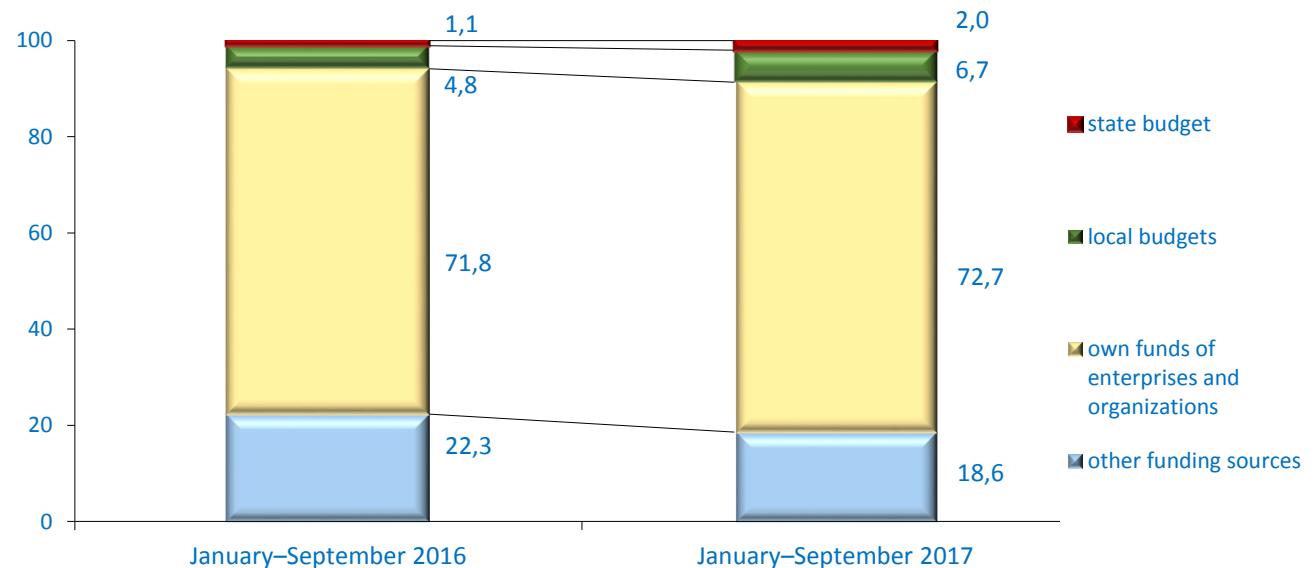

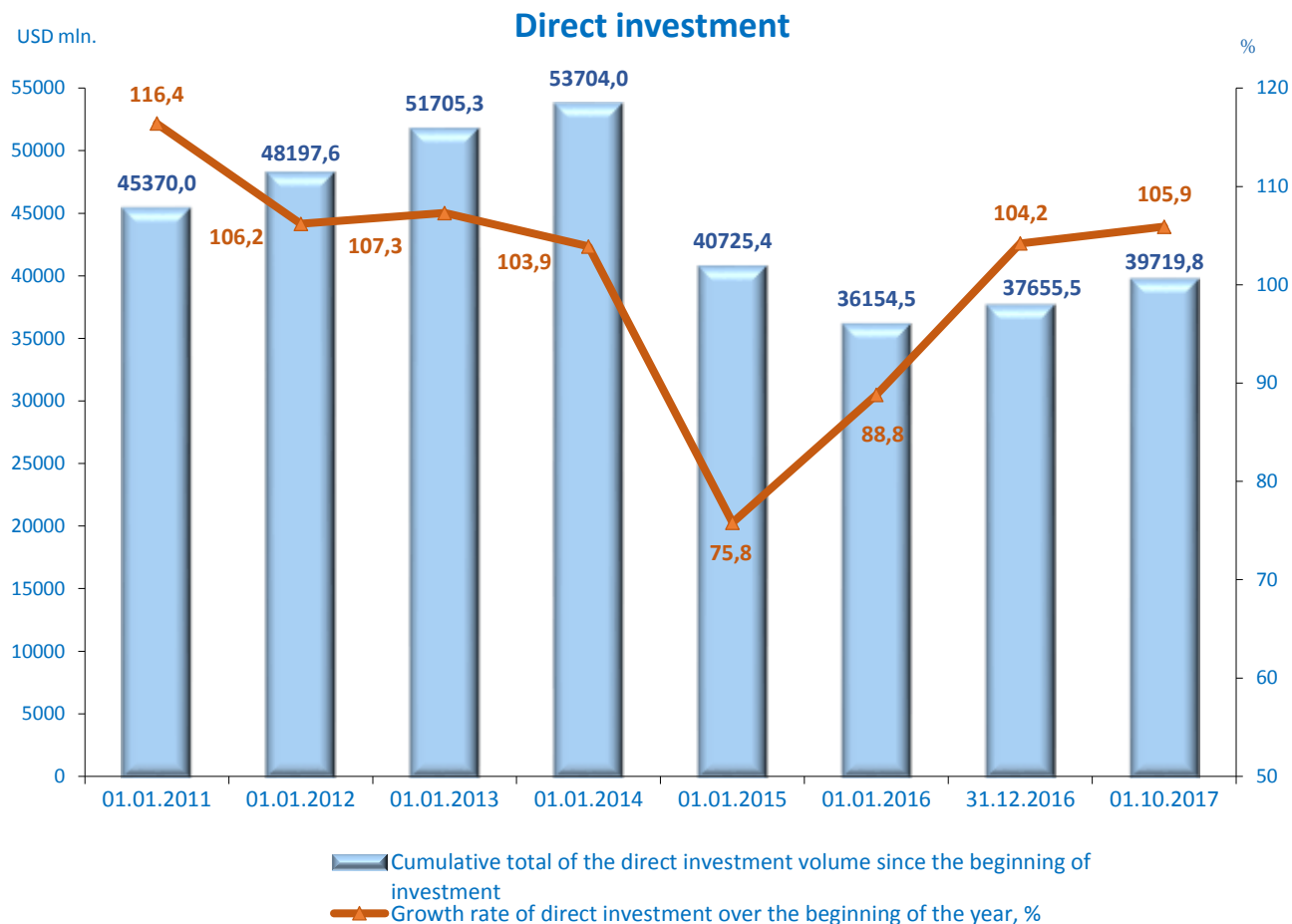

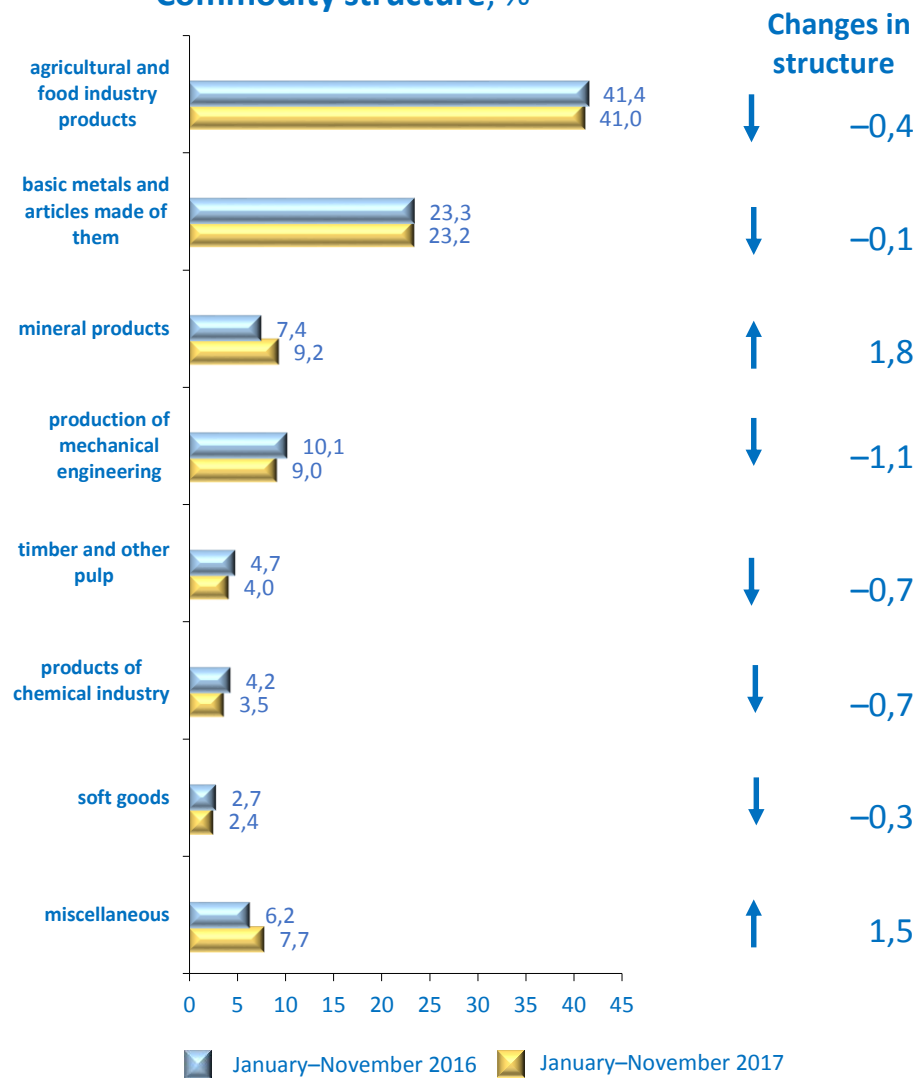

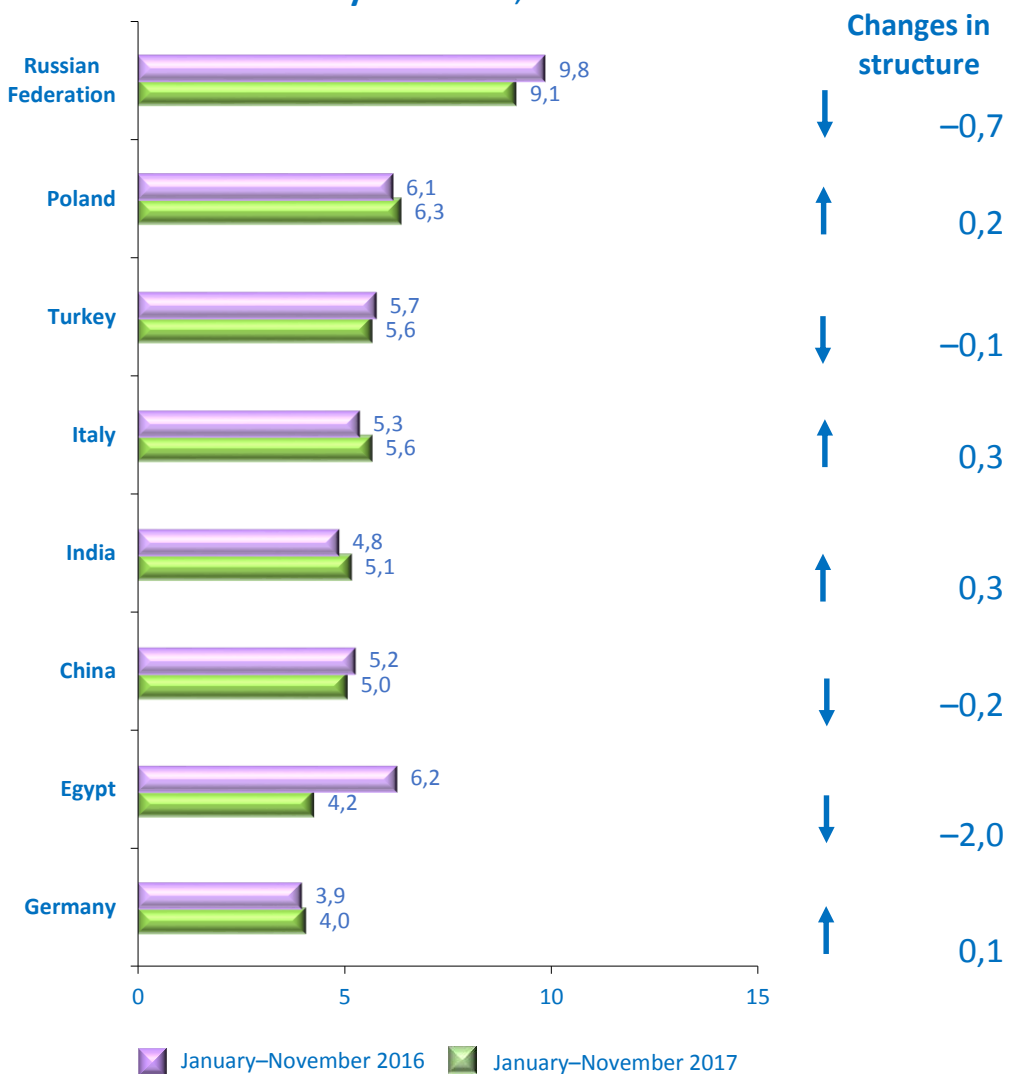


Exports of goods

Country structure, %



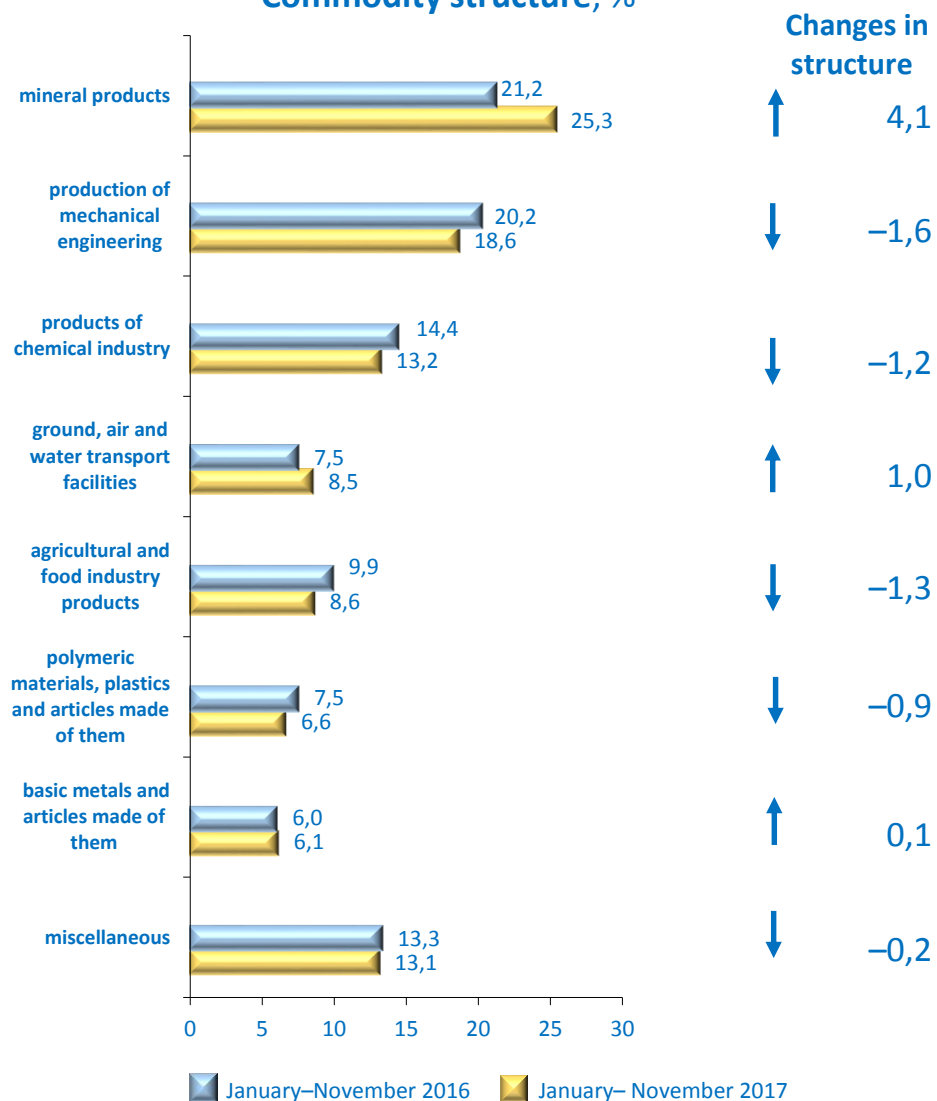

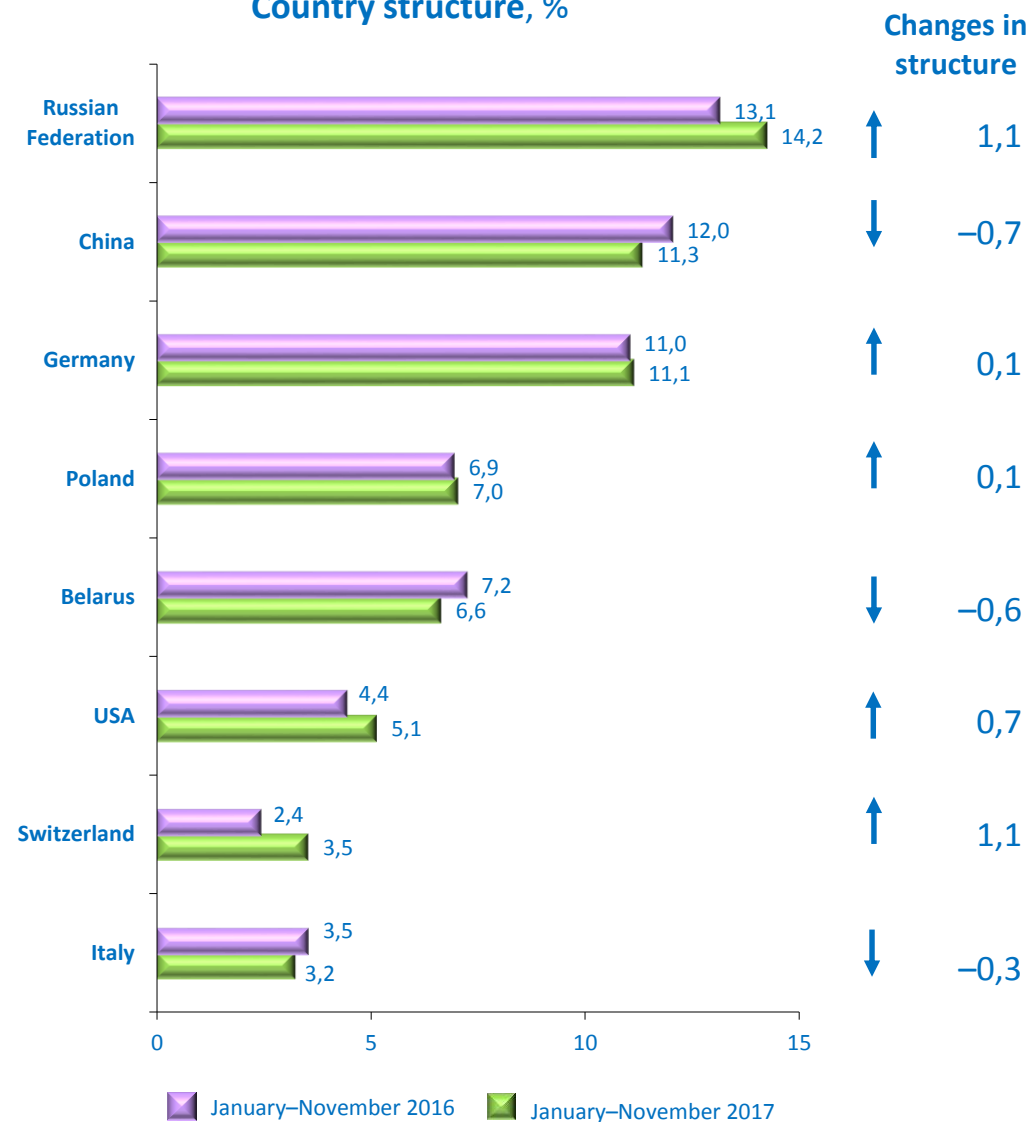

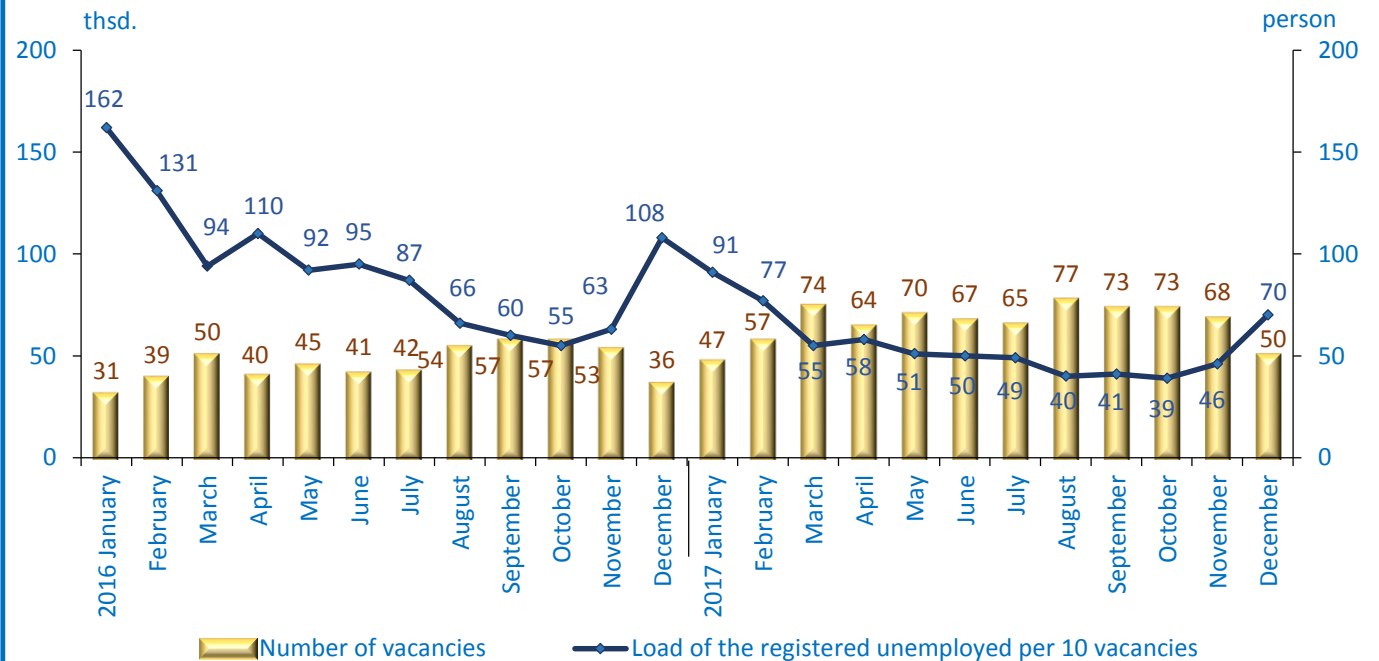

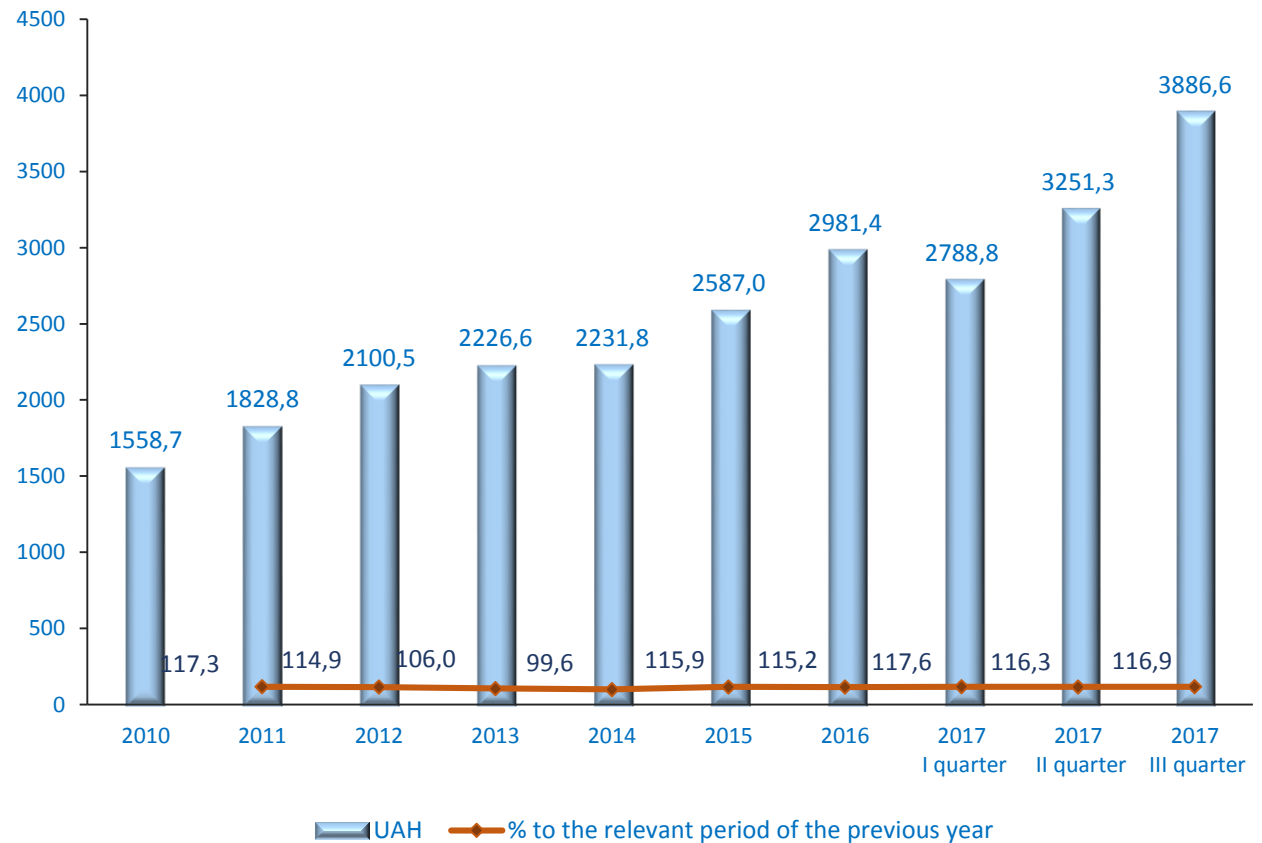

Average monthly disposable income, per capita¹



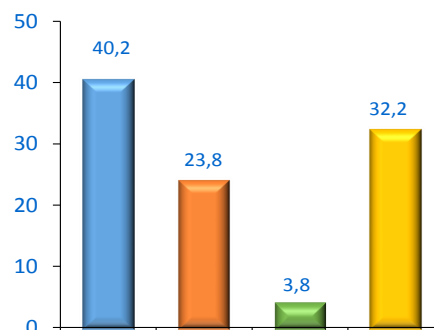

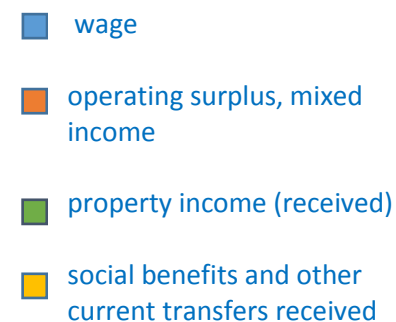

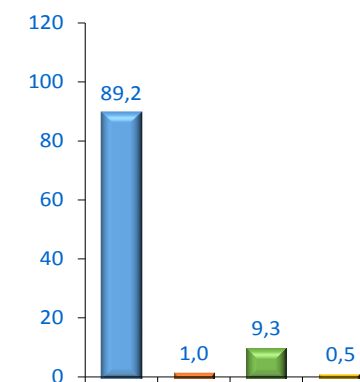
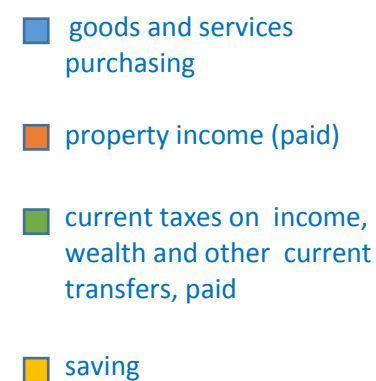
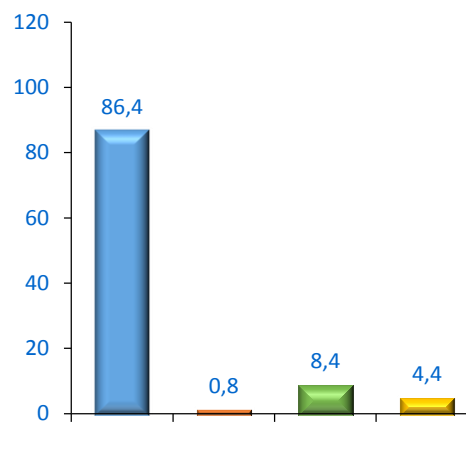
Structure of income

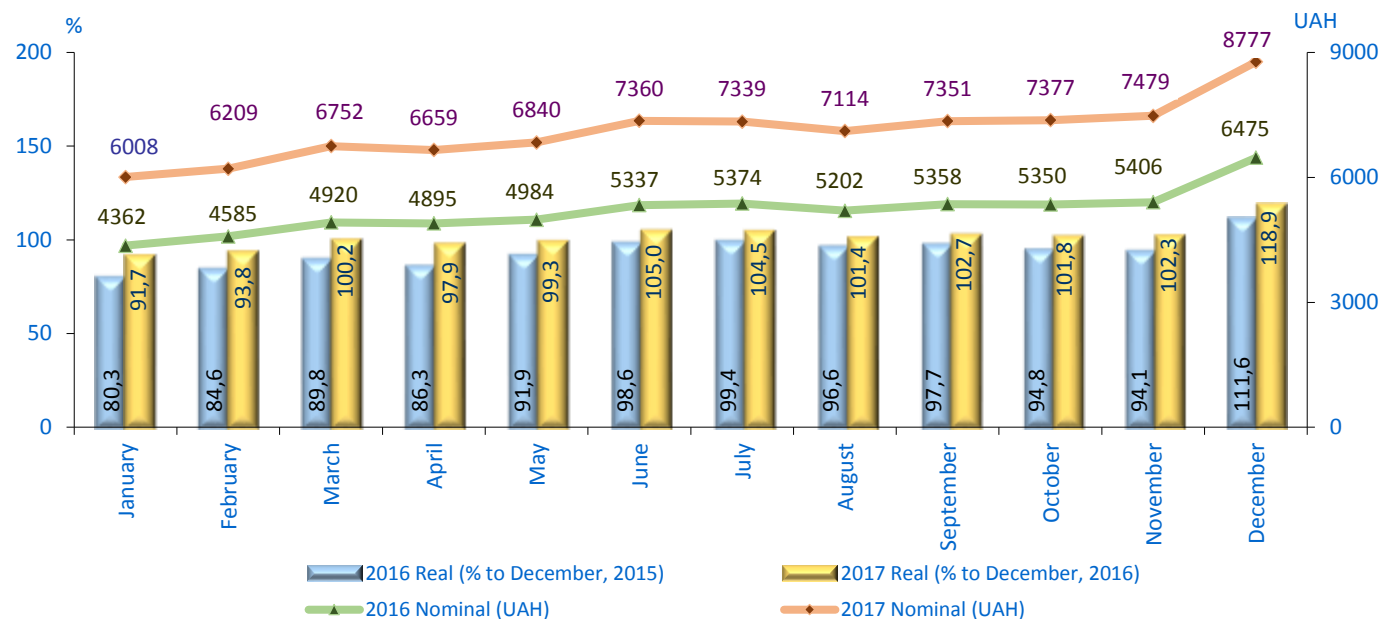

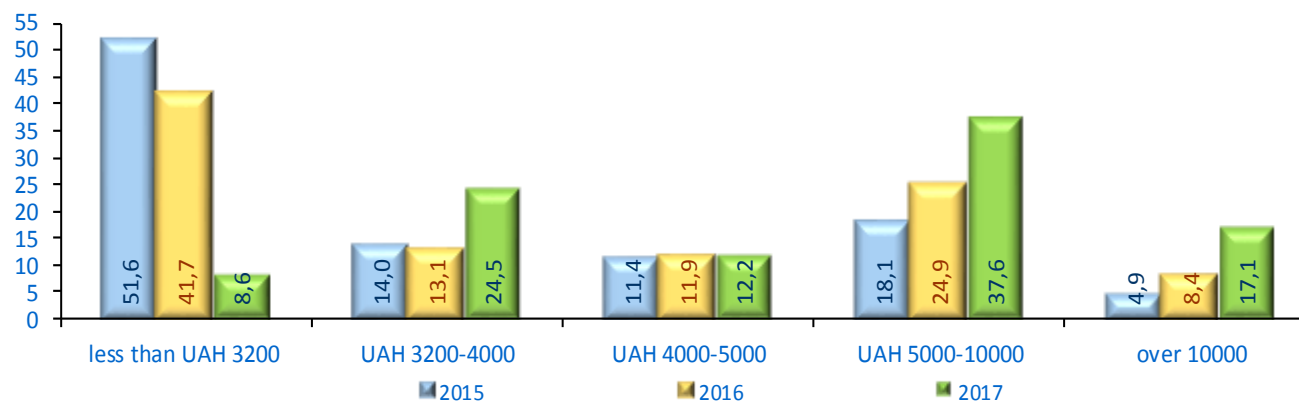

Nominal and real wage trends



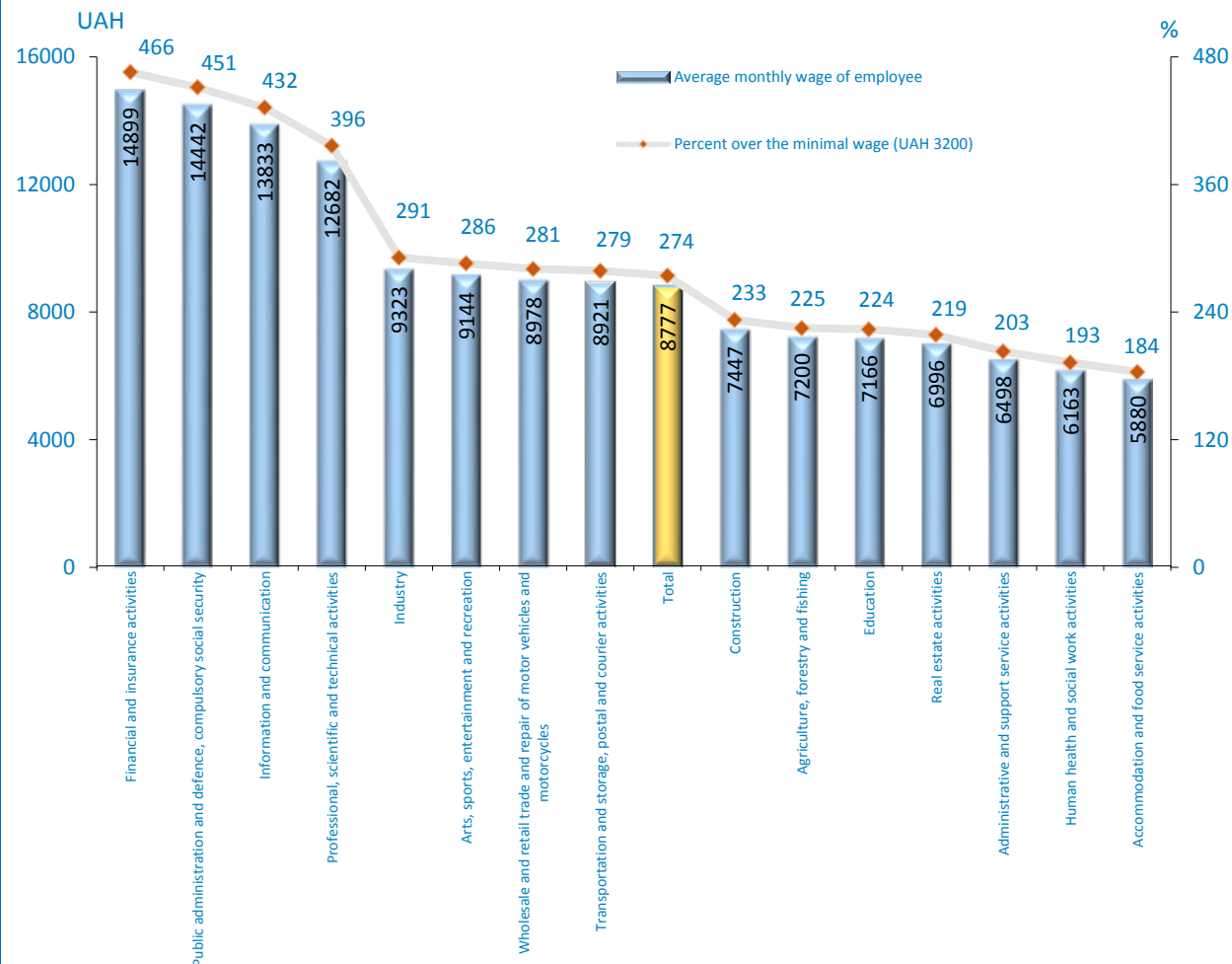
Regular employees by wage level in September, %

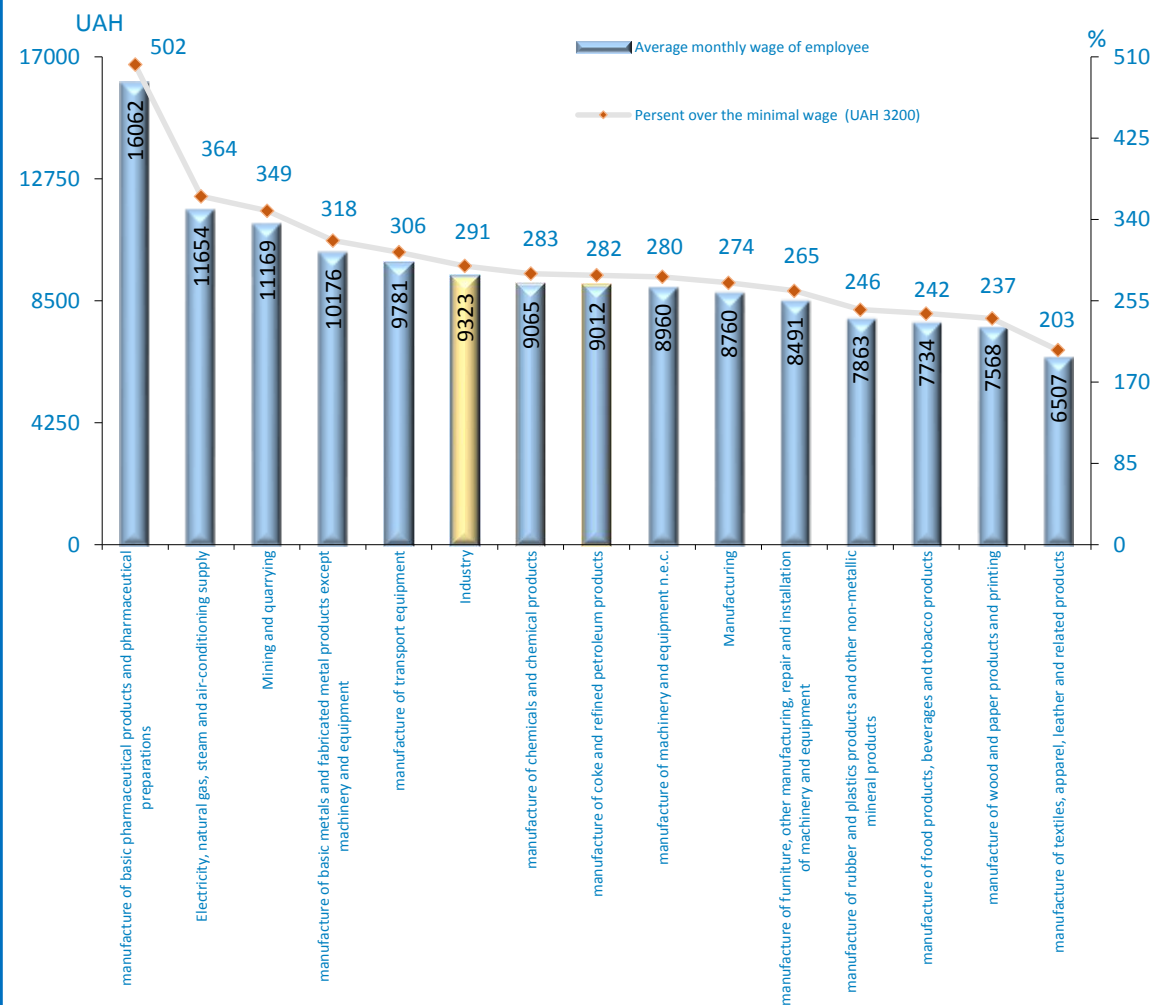

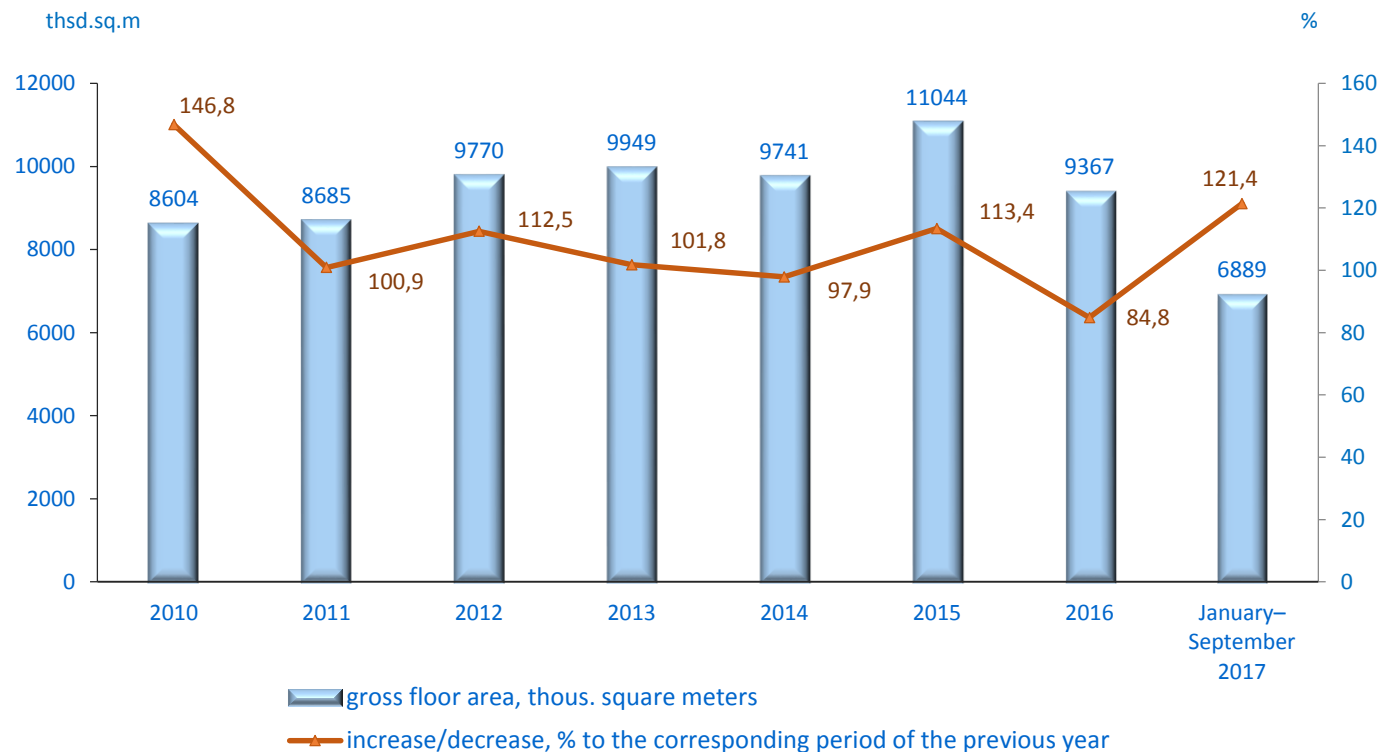

Housing put into service



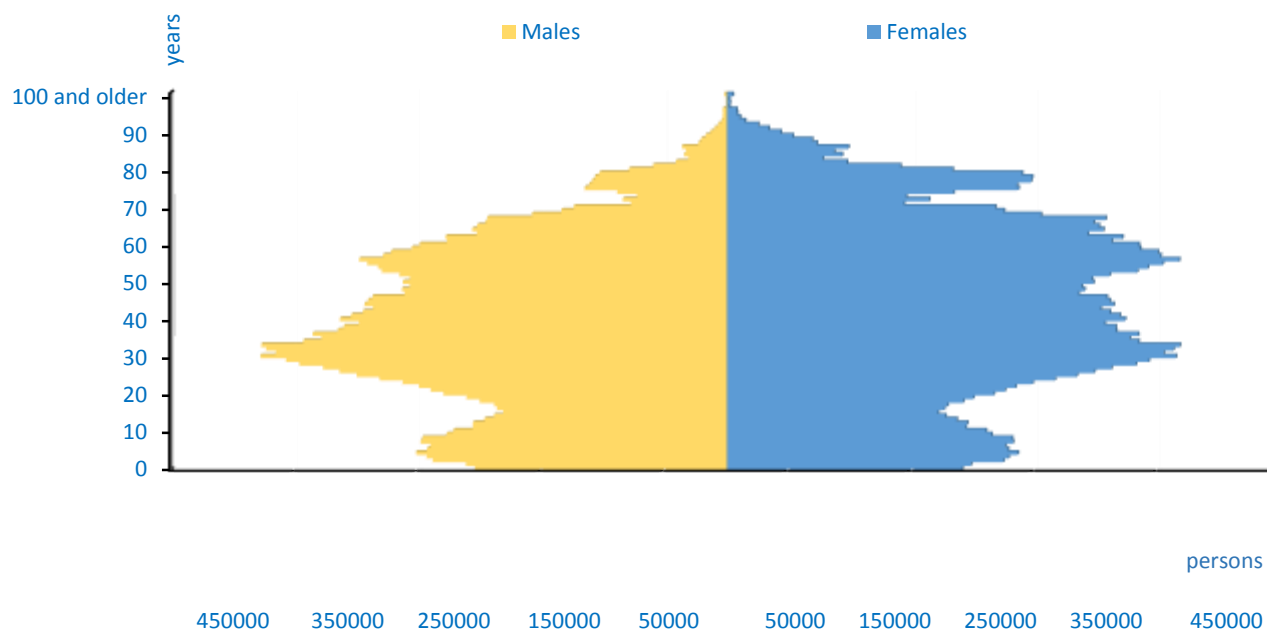
