


Gross value added structure for III quarter 2019, %




GDP by final use categories, %






GDP by final use categories, %


Gross value added structure by type of economic activity, %


PPI changes by type of industrial activity, %
(November over December of the previous year)










Number of agricultural animals



Winter crops for grain and green fodder were sown on the area of 9,0 mln.ha for 2020 harvest, that is by 0,1% more than the indicator for the previous year, including cereals for grain – 7,6 mln.ha (by 0,2% more), rape for grain – 1,3 mln.ha (by 0,3% more). In the structure of areas under winter cereals for grain, the share of wheat is 85,0%, barley – 13,3% and rye – 1,5%.




Increase, decrease (–) of the capital investment, %








Increase, decrease (-) of trade in goods and services, %
(to the previous period)





Commodity structure, %



Average monthly disposable income, per capita






Structure of income






Regular employees by wage level in September, %








