


Gross value added structure for I quarter 2020, %




GDP by final use categories, %






GDP by final use categories, %



GDP by income categories, %




Gross value added structure by type of economic activity, %






CPI and PPI changes, %


PPI changes by type of industrial activity, %
(May over December of the previous year)










Growth rate of animal products production, %








Increase, decrease (–) of the capital investment, % (to the corresponding period of the previous year)





Commodity structure, %





Unemployment rate of population aged 15–70 years (by ILO methodology) (in % to labour force of relevant age)





Average monthly disposable income, per capita










Regular employees by wage level in March, %







Residential buildings put into service




