


**Expectations of industrial enterprises

regarding the development of their business activity**




Information from March 2022 to January 2024 has been compiled on the basis of reports actually submitted by enterprises.

¹ The indicator is calculated by the method of calculation of indicators of business expectations, approved by order of the SSSU of 03 December, 2021 No 301 (with changes).


**Assessment of current stock of finished products

(seasonal adjustment)**




**Assessment of industrial production

(seasonal adjustment)**




**Assessment of current export order-books (export demand)

(seasonal adjustment)**




**Expected changes in selling prices
for the products of industry over the next 3 months**




Expected changes in employment at industrial enterprises over the next 3 months (seasonal adjustment)




Availability of orders to industrial enterprises
