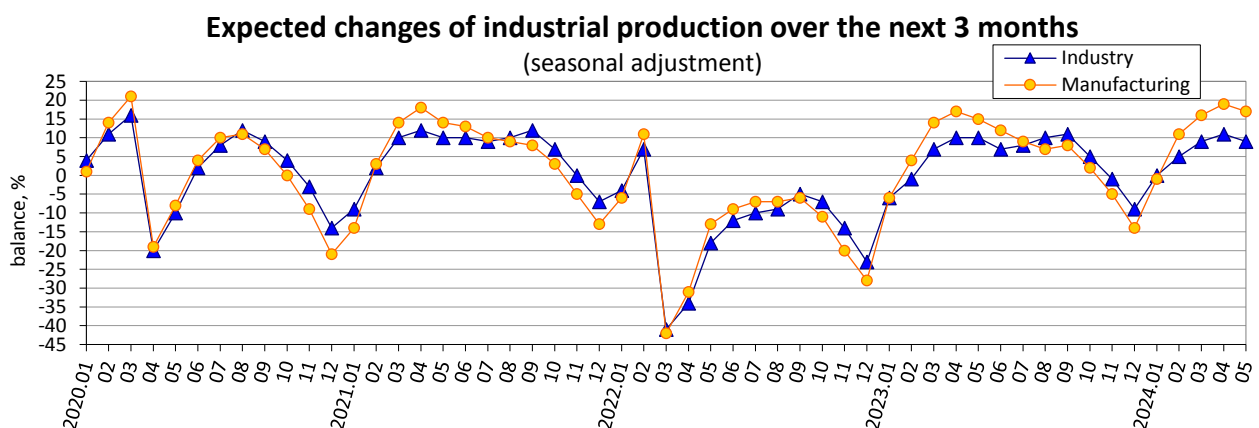
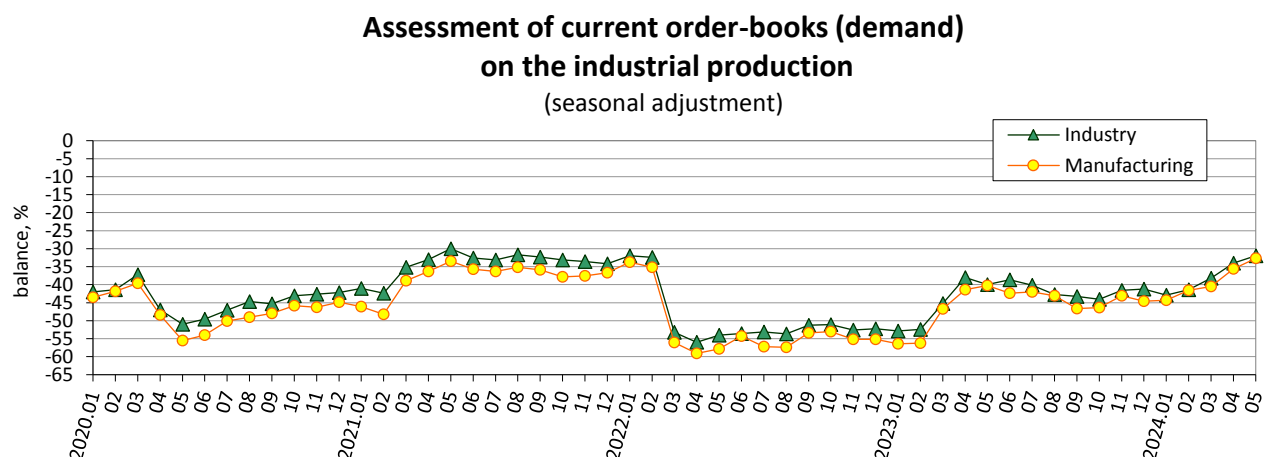
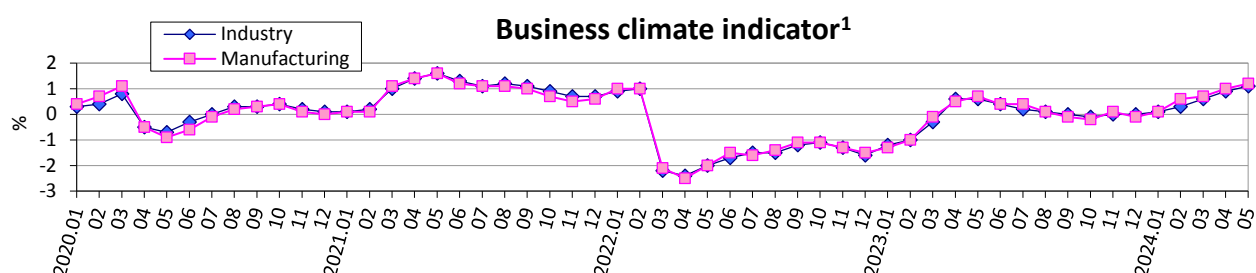
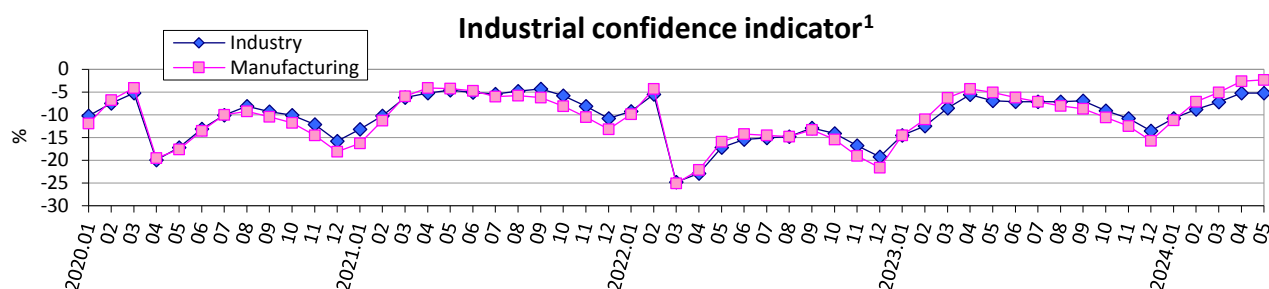


# Expectations of industrial enterprises in May 2024 regarding the development of their business activity

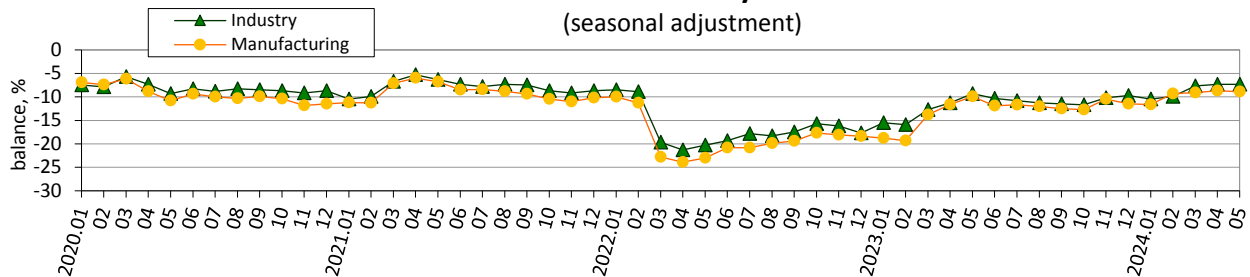

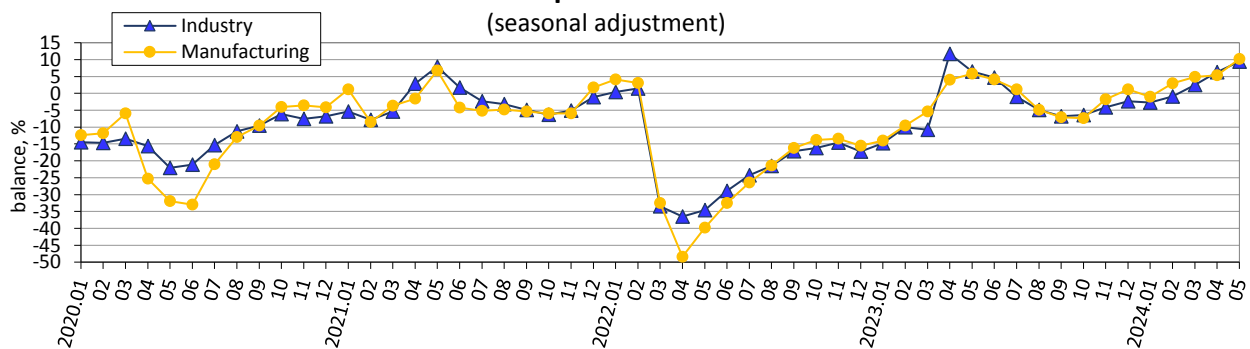
Information from March 2022 to May 2024 has been compiled on the basis of reports actually submitted by enterprises.

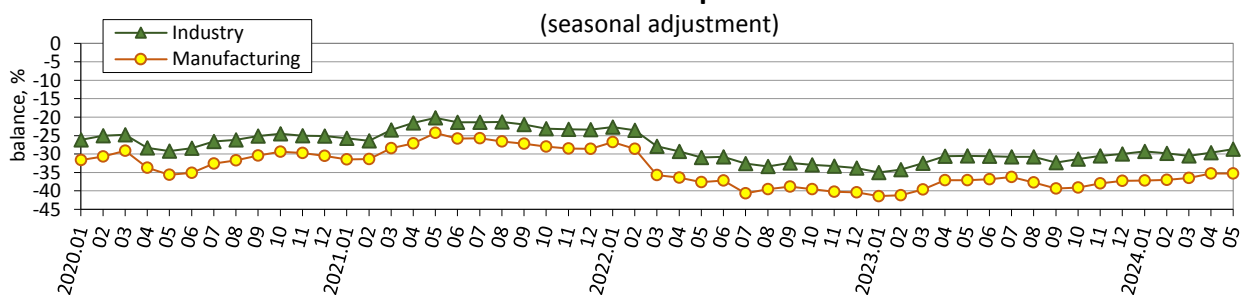
### Assessment of current stock of finished products in industry



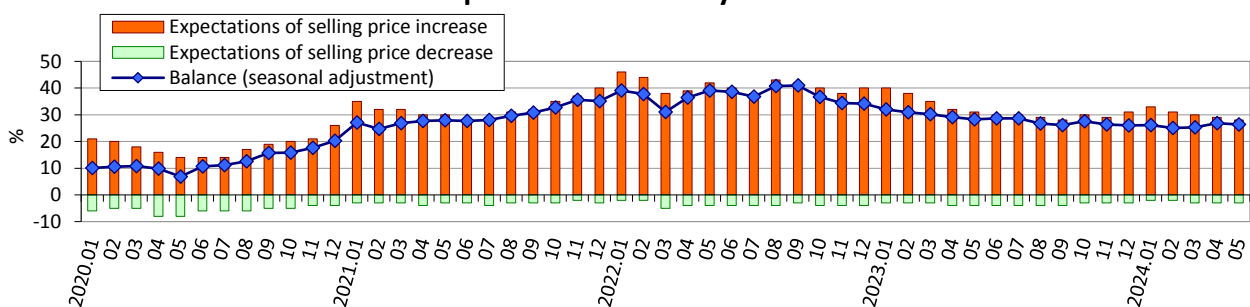
### Assessment of industrial production in the past 3 months



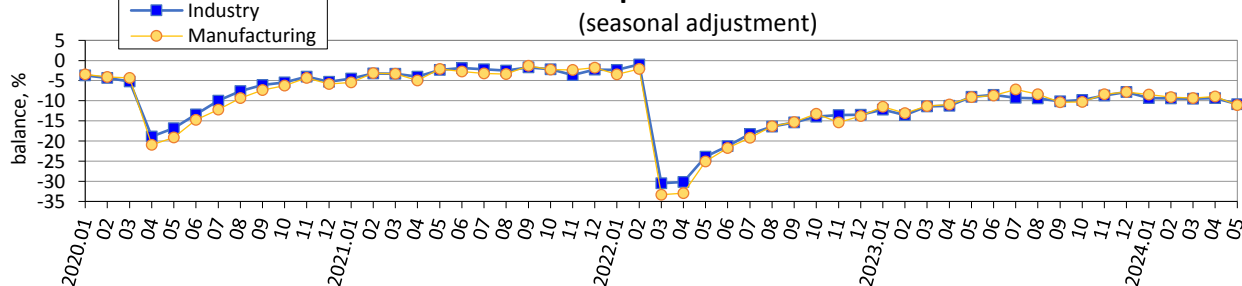
### Assessment of current export order-books (export demand) on the industrial production

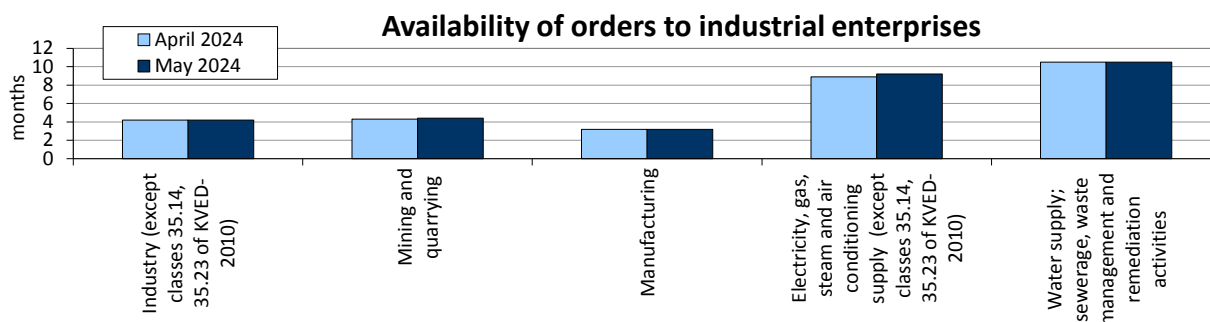


### Expected changes in selling prices for the products of industry over the next 3 months
