






Expectations of industrial enterprises in October 2025 regarding the development of their business activity






Assessment of current stock of finished products in industry (seasonal adjustment)




Assessment of industrial production in the past 3 months in the past 3 months (seasonal adjustment)




Assessment of current export order-books (export demand) on the industrial production (seasonal adjustment)




Expected changes in selling prices for the products of industry over the next 3 months




Expected changes in employment at industrial enterprises over the next 3 months (seasonal adjustment)




Availability of orders to industrial enterprises
